Plant Name:

Paraphalaenopsis (Pps.) labukensis

Exhibitor:

John Roberts

Housing: Half covered shade house in Summer, converted into closed warm house in Winter. Hangs up high for extra light .

Feeding: Blood & Bone + dolomite in the mix.
Then what ever goes.

Watering: Tank water - early morning in Winter / late afternoon in Summer

Potting Medium: Peat & Perlite mix with small bark.

Other Cultural Notes: Having long cylindrical leaves this species requires more light than its relatives the Phalaenopsis.
