**Housing:**

The plant is hanging in a *Magnolia Grandiflora* 'Little Gem' tree approximately 3m from the ground on the North Eastern side of the tree. The area is well ventilated and under-planted with Bromeliads to help with humidity

**Feeding**

Occasional foliar spray with a liquid fertilizer mainly when I remember.

**Watering:**

Tank water is used when available. Watering by hand as well as when mother nature supplies.

**Any Other Cultural Notes:**

The word *Acampe* was derived from the Greek word *Akampas*, meaning rigid, referring, to the little, brittle, inflexible flowers.
